FNASAT - Gens du voyage

FNASAT, which was born out of the post war voluntary movement, now maintains a network of a hundred structures in French territory; launches and pilots projects of a national and European dimension; runs a media-tech resource centre (containing 7000 reference documents) and has been the publisher of the journal Etudes tsiganes (Gypsy Studies) since 1955.

FNASAT and the HALDE

FNASAT – Gens du Voyage and its members have used the missions of the HALDE, as much as to gain legal recognition of the discrimination to which Roma and Travellers in France are subjected to, as to bring the issue to the public eye.

In the framework of the European Year for Equal Opportunities, FNASAT, with the support of the HALDE, led a series of training courses for travellers and supported the distribution of a film produced by the HALDE across its network of stakeholders and partners.
