European Parliament: List of relevant Intergroups

European Parliament Intergroups "can be formed by Members of the European Parliament from any political group and any committee, with a view to holding **informal exchanges of views** on particular subjects and promoting contact between Members and civil society."

Following the election of the **new European Parliament** in May 2014, a list of new Intergroups has been adopted. Among the most relevant ones, we can mention:

- The LGBTI Intergroup
- The Freedom of Religion and Belief and Religious Tolerance Intergroup
- The Anti-Racism and Diversity Intergroup
- The Disability Intergroup

EU Horizontal Directive: Latest State of Play

Political discussions on the **Horizontal Directive** (Directive proposal covering the grounds of age, disability, religion and belief and sexual orientation beyond the field of employment) have accelerated in recent months. All three institutions involved in EU law-making seem to have defined this Directive as a priority (see recent Equinet Internal Note). However, a handful of Member States still maintain reservations.



In March 2015, Equinet Secretariat **met with Ulrike Lunacek** (European Parliament Rapporteur of the proposal of Directive) and EU Civil Society organisations to share information and coordinate upcoming actions.

EU Agencies sign joint statement to strengthen fundamental rights' protection in the EU

On 20th February 2015, **heads of all EU agencies** met in Brussels and committed to strengthen fundamental rights' protection in their areas of work and internal management. The joint statement is available here.



Results of the public consultation on the Europe 2020

The Commission has adopted a Communication on the results of the public consultation on the **Europe 2020 strategy for smart, sustainable and inclusive growth**. These results will pave the way for a review of the Europe 2020 strategy later this year.

EUROPE 2020

At the same time Eurostat, the EU's statistical office published a report on the state-of-play of the EU 2020 indicators showing the progress achieved and the challenges remaining in each field.

New Directive as regards disclosure of non-financial and diversity information

The Council adopted a new Directive amending Directive 2013/34/EU as regards disclosure of non-financial and **diversity information by certain large undertakings and groups**. The amended Directive will have to be transposed by EU Member States by June 2015.



Latvian Presidency of the EU (1st January - 30th June 2015)

On 1st January 2015, **Latvia** took up the Presidency of the Council of the EU. This semester, focus will be put on **competitiveness** and **Digital Europe**. Priorities and programme of the Latvian Presidency are available here.

New EU rules for better protection of victims of violence in the EU

In January 2015, two new instruments to ensure better protection of victims of violence in the EU entered into application:

- The Regulation on Mutual Recognition of Protection Measures in Civil Matters
- The Directive on the European Protection Order
