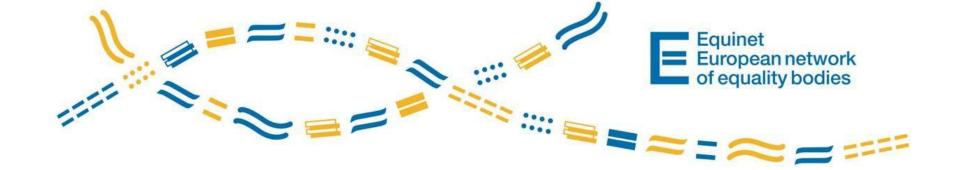

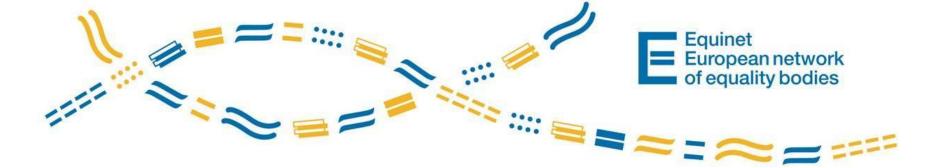


2014 CONTEXT

- Audit of accounts 2013
- Action grant 2014 from the EC (new, heavier reporting rules)
- Submission of Budget 2015 (New EC Programme Framework)







AUDIT 2013

- "MINI AUDIT" by the European Commission of our submitted accounts 2013
- Third audit in two years
- 14,483eur of real expenses rejected by the EC (out of 778,842eur) but Equinet contesting 9,175eur
- With the currently rejected costs, Equinet ends 2013 with a real cash loss of 1,808eur

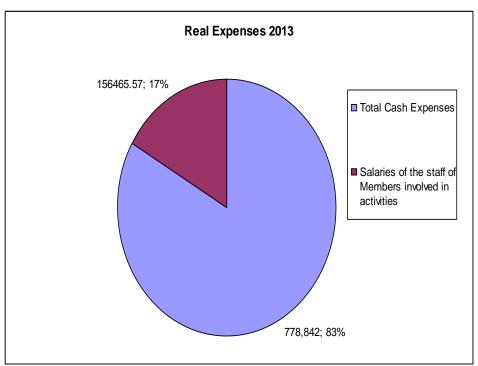

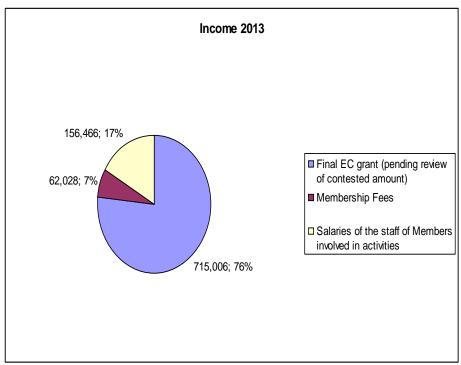






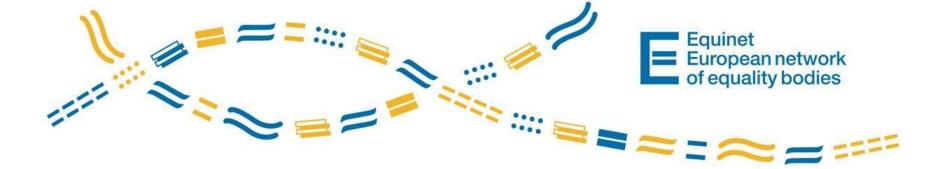

Equinet Budget 2014

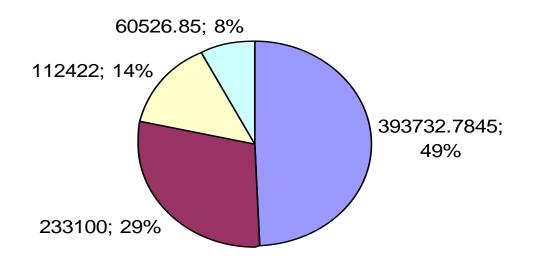
- The Rights, Equality and Citizenship Programme 2014-2020 was not ready for the start of 2014
- EC funding gap-bridging solution: reallocation of some remaining PROGRESS funds
- But 1-year ACTION GRANT instead of Operating Grant
 Time commitments eligible
- More Stringent reporting rules



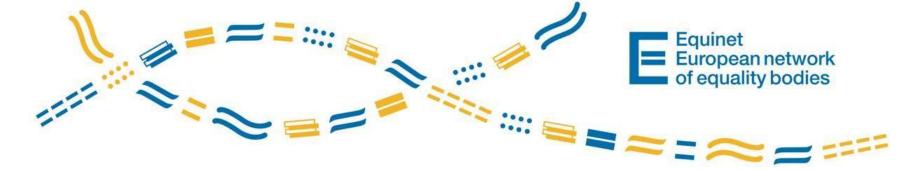




Equinet budget 2014

- □ Indirect costs

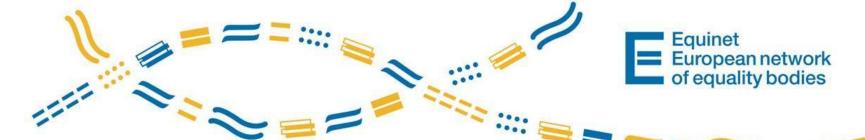

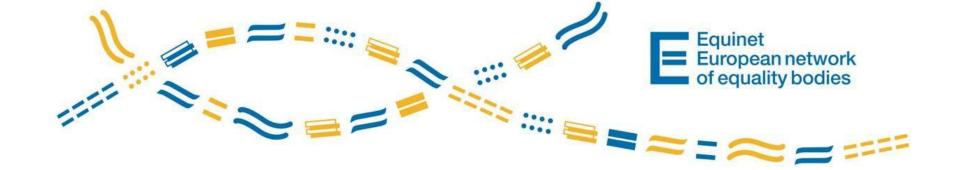


What We Need From Members For The Salary Costs 2014

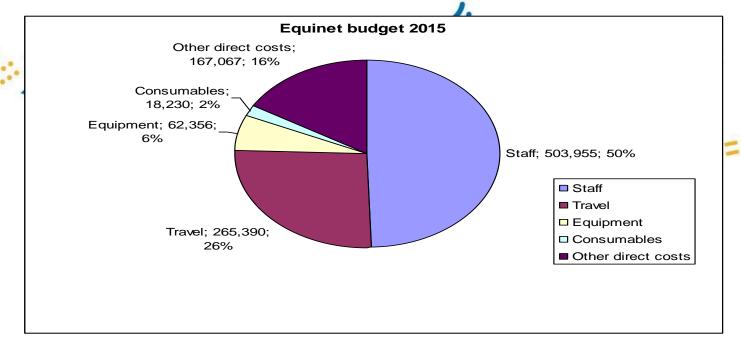


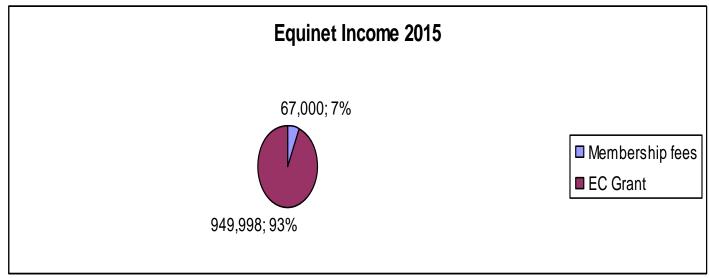
Equinet in 2015 and beyond

- De facto Monopoly
- Rights, Equality and Citizenship Programme 2014-2020
- New set of rules: co-funding minimum 5% (instead of +/- 25% before) → Should be able to cover it only with Membership Fees (no need for salary costs of Members anymore)



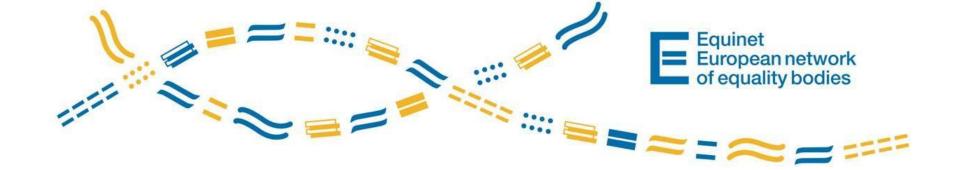












Conclusions
