


Functions of Equality Bodies:

 - Recommendations on discrimination issues


Context:

- Various Challenges faced by NEBs






Current challenges – need for standards

 - Stakeholder engagement






Equinet Mission

It supports equality bodies to be independent and effective as valuable catalysts for more equal societies


Equinet Cluster on Standards for Equality Bodies(Work Plan 2015)
