Tackling discrimination and ensuring dismissal protection for carers in Europe: strengthening links between equality bodies and labour inspectorates

BACKGROUND INFORMATION AND CONTEXT

In the context of the Work-Life Balance Initiative adopted by the Commission on 26 April 2017, the European Commission identified as one of the actions to improve the design and gender balanced take-up of family related leaves and flexible working arrangements. One of the issues identified is discrimination related to pregnancy and parenthood on the labour market. Indeed, effective dismissal protection is crucial, including the periods surrounding pregnancy and maternity/family leave, for women and men. Some reports show that workers still face unfavorable treatment in their workplace and report a lack of information and support in many Member States. The seminar is organized by Equinet and the European Commission, in partnership with the European Economic and Social Committee, and draw on the needs and experiences of national equality bodies in order to better support persons experiencing discriminatory dismissal in cooperation with stakeholders such as for instance labour inspectorates, but also other actors such as trade unions. The seminar is an opportunity to exchange experiences and good practices among equality bodies and other stakeholders on the labour market.

PARTICIPANTS

This seminar is addressed to equality bodies' staff members and labour inspectors dealing with pregnancy and maternity discrimination, dismissal protection and family related leaves in the context of work-life balance. It allows for participation with different professional backgrounds, including legal, policy, and communication. Participants will follow different workshops according to their area of expertise.
